Dear Stream Team Volunteer Water Quality Monitor,

Enclosed is the 2018 Level 1 Volunteer Water Quality Monitoring Workshop Schedule. This level of training includes chemical monitoring, visual survey, and a review of invertebrate identification techniques.

To attend a Level 1 Workshop, a monitor must have attended an Introductory Level Workshop* and submitted the following:

- Site Selection form with a map of monitoring site location
- Stream Discharge data sheet
- Biological Monitoring data sheet

Prerequisite data may be submitted with the workshop registration form.

Each workshop is free of charge and consists of six (6) hours of classroom instruction and one to two hours on a stream to demonstrate sampling methods. Although the level of material presented is not designed for children, older youth accompanied by an adult are welcome (maximum 3 per adult).

Need a refresher course? Monitors are welcome to register for a workshop as a refresher and are encouraged to attend if a few years have passed since their last training.

Complete the online registration form at mostreamteam.org or fill out and return the attached form.

You will receive a confirmation letter and directions after the registration deadline date. Class size will be limited to 20 people per workshop and is filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. *Individuals under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.*
